Atashinda Child Sponsorship

Some children or their siblings in the sponsorship program are ready for high school or to learn a trade. Regular child sponsorship is not enough to cover the cost of this education. To sponsor a young person in high school or to learn a trade as well as to cater for their other needs costs as little as an extra \$60/year and is vital to stopping the cycle of poverty that these children find themselves in.

Kamukuywa Lela Children's Home

This home is a partnership between AinA, CMA D UK & CBM. 60 orphaned children who were being cared for by Bro. Justus & Sis. Annett in Kenya, now have a place to call home. The children are sponsored by AinA child sponsors and project sponsors cover the additional costs of running a home and supporting these children. They came to Justus & Annett gradually over the past few years looking for something to eat and Justus & Annett simply could not turn them away. Sponsors receive regular updates and photographs of the children. 'Lela' means 'caring'.

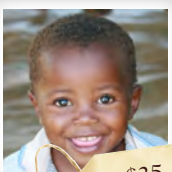

In the same way as child sponsorship, these schools provide children with basic needs including a nutrition program, education, uniforms, shoes and medical checks. Sponsors contribute to the group of children and receive regular updates, photographs and correspondence from the teachers and children.
